WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBILITY AT HILLSIDE GARDEN BY CAR OR TAXI



Parking: There is parking outside the office on Roman Pavement and surrounding streets close to the garden.

What.Three.Words: slang.basin.voter

The natural topography of the garden means there are uneven surfaces and small changes in elevation throughout.

There is a wheelchair accessible toilet in the garden, which is 84m from the garden gate.

Useful Measurements:

- **Garden Gate Width: 87 inches**
- **Garden Paths Width: 67 inches**
- **Kerb Depth in Garden: 2 inches**
- **Viking Path from Arboretum: 8ft at the widest point/42 inches at narrowest**



Ground: Grass, Tiles, Tarmac, Stones

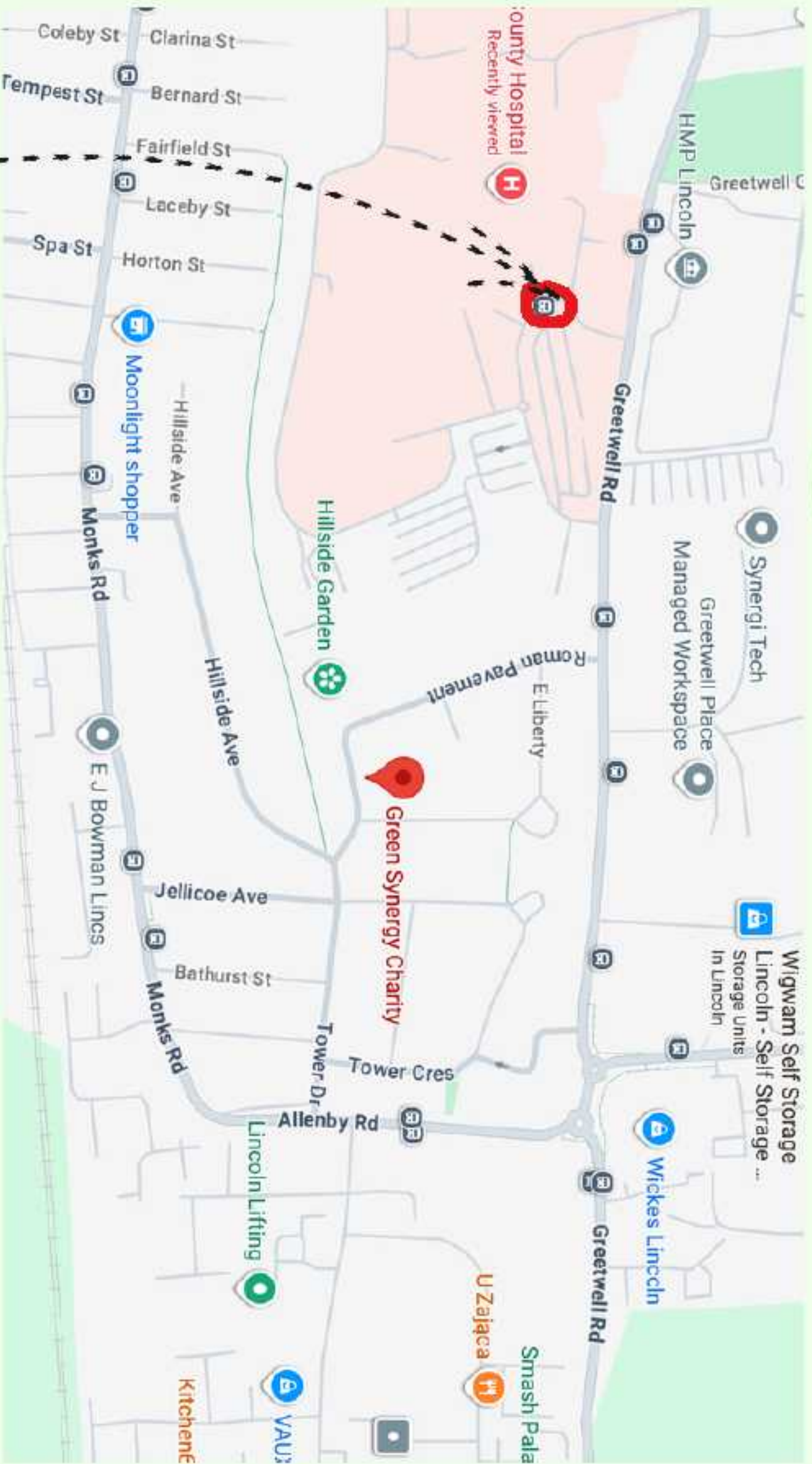
CATCHING THE BUS TO GREEN SYNERGY

Lincoln has many bus routes that can drop you near to our garden. The buses have wheelchair spaces and low-floor access.

- The number 4 and 56 bus takes you from Lincoln Bus Station to Lincoln County Hospital, where the garden is downhill 429m on a mix of paved and non-paved surfaces. Buses run every 30 minutes.
- Buses M1, M2 and 3 take you to Hartley Street, which is uphill to the garden.
- Buses 53, 56, 50, 53A take you to Lime Kiln Way, which is 226m downhill to the Green Synergy office.
- If you live within 10 miles of Lincoln City Centre, you can try Dial-A-Ride, which many of our participants use, which drops you off right outside the Green Synergy office. Green Synergy can assist with arranging this, or call: 01522 544 983

CATCHING THE TRAIN TO GREEN SYNERGY

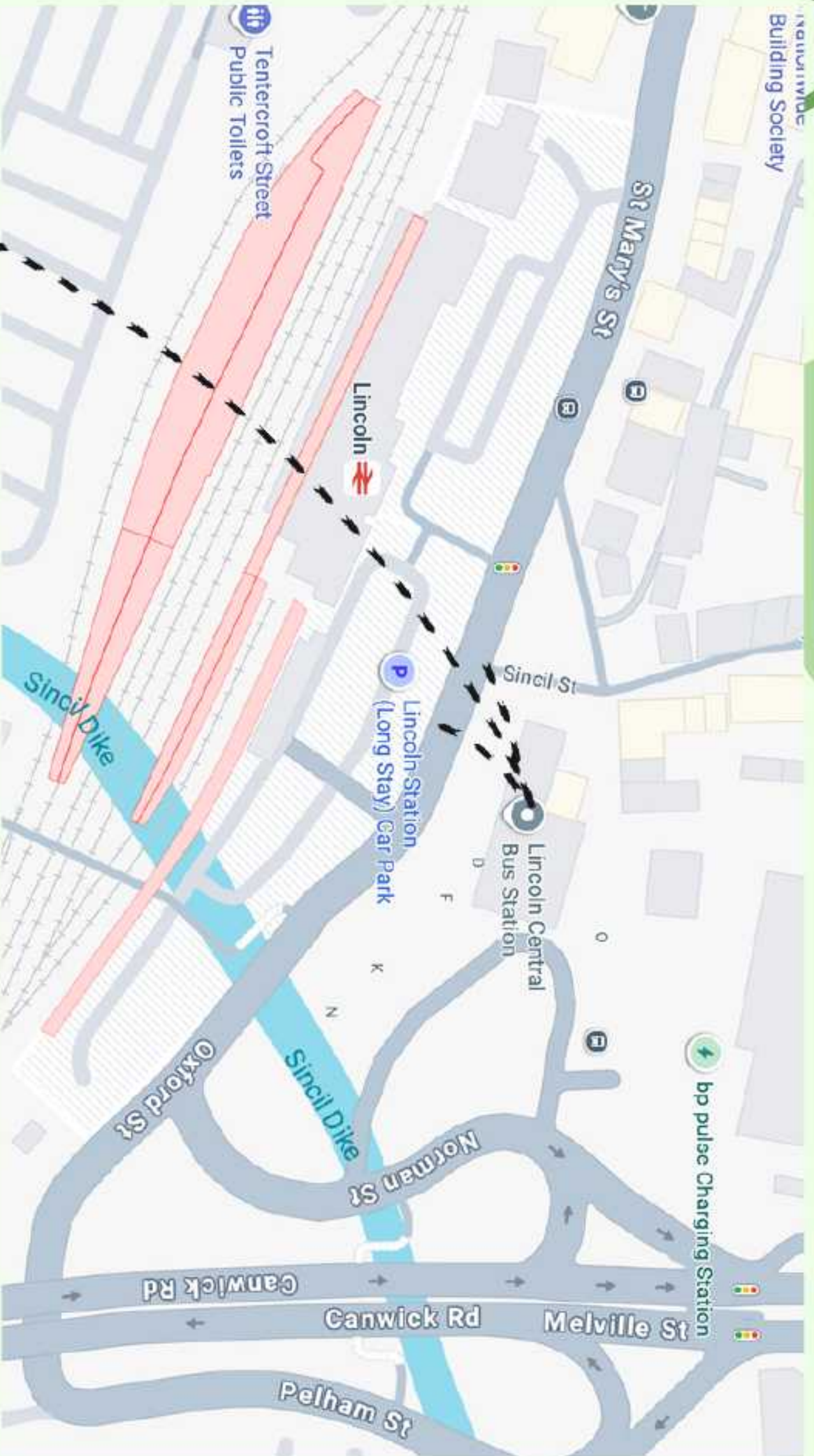
If travelling to Lincoln by train, you will arrive at Lincoln Central. The station has step-free access, accessible toilets and assistance is available if booked through your train operator.

As you exit the station, cross over the road to the bus station. Alternatively, you can call a taxi.

ACCESSING THE GARDEN



Once you have arrived, the garden can be reached down a wide tarmacked track. You will see a large graffitied wall saying Green Synergy on your left. On your right, you will see a black metal gate. This is Hillside Garden.

The paths around the garden are rocky with grassy areas where the activities take place. Most activities take place in our Children's Garden which has a small gradient up to enter.

The toilet is located next to the polytunnel.

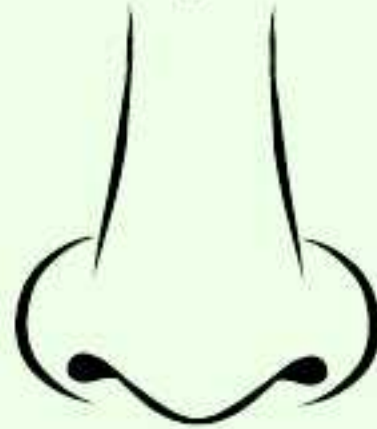

WHAT TO EXPECT

There are many different sights, smells, textures and noises in the garden. Here are a few examples:

Smells: Soil, Fumes, Herbs and Plants



Noises: Garden Equipment, Helicopter, Tools, Wildlife



Textures: Grass, Soil, Water, Plants
